Automated Decision Support Background

- VBA has prioritized the leveraging of available technology to automate specific areas of development.
- The goal of Automated Decision Support is to improve timeliness and efficiency and prevent future backlogs in claims processing.
- Technology, data and employee feedback was leveraged to automate administrative tasks and reduce burden for VBA employees.
- Automated Decision Support will result in:
 Faster more accurate and consistent decisions
 Creating a better user experience for processors
 Enhanced customer experience for Veteran's and their beneficiaries







Ready for Decision and Automated Exam Functionality

Ready for Decision

- Medical evidence related to claimed conditions will be identified and compiled from Veterans' electronic health records
- Medical evidence within Veterans' VBMS eFolders will be identified and compiled
- Military service and medical evidence necessary to decide the claim will be intelligently indexed within the Automated Review Summary Document (ARSD)

Automated Examinations

- When there is not enough medical evidence to decide the claim, an automated examination request will be submitted through the VBMS Exam Management System
- Automated Review Summary Documents (ARSDs) will be associated with Veterans' VBMS eFolders to allow examiners to quickly identify and review evidence relevant to the examination
- Intelligently indexed records within the ARSD will enable examiners to complete more Acceptable Clinical Evidence (ACE) examinations

Automated Decision Support- Definitions

- All Automated Eligible Claims: all contentions on the claim are eligible for automation
- Multi-Issue Claims: one or more automation eligible contentions AND one or more non-automation eligible contentions
- Automated Review Summary Document (ARSD): decision support document in the Veteran's e-Folder, documenting military service, relevant medical evidence, other medical evidence, and rating schedule
- Draft Exam: examination is drafted, as there are multiple nonautomated contentions requiring review

Identifying an Automated Decision Support Claim

- Every claim that has been through ADS will have a *Rapid RFD* Special Issue attached to it.
- On multi-issue automation claims, the *Automated* APC Special Issue will be attached to it.
- Additionally, a claim that has gone through automation will have the **ARSD** listed in the Veteran's eFolder









User Role Responsibility

- ADS assists claims processors in making fast, accurate, and consistent decisions for Veterans.
 VA employees can expect to see the ARSD in the eFolder and draft examinations generated for eligible claims.
- ADS plays a role for each VBA employees processing claims:
 - Veterans Service Representative: VSRs may see draft examinations in VBMS and are required to take the appropriate steps in ordering an exam. VSRs are responsible for confirming if an ADS claim requires additional development actions.
 - **Rating Veterans Service Representative**: RVSRs are responsible for reviewing relevant evidence and making a decision on the Veterans claim. RVSRs can utilize the ARSD as a decision support tool to assist with quickly identifying evidence and locating key terms to help with their final decision.
 - **Quality Review Specialist:** The QRS will begin seeing Individual Quality Reviews for claims impacted by automation. They should continue following current review policies and procedures for these claims.









Automated Review Summary Document

- There are two ways an ARSD is generated in the eFolder:
 - Mail Automation Services (MAS)
 - -VA.gov
- VA.gov generates an ARSD for *only* claims for increase on Hypertension and Asthma claims
- All other automation eligible claims are sent to MAS for establishment

Automated Review Summary Document-MAS

- The ARSD is a tool used to efficiently identify documents in the Veteran's eFolder to assist claims processors in their review
- It supports identifying possible military service related to presumptive conditions (if applicable to the contention) and possible evaluation criteria
- The ARSD is generated and uploaded to the Veterans eFolder only for contentions eligible for Automated Decision Support.

- Each diagnostic code has its own set of key terms related to the rating schedule, as well as a medical history (lab findings and other significant data)

If there is schedular evidence within the review period, or if the contention is at the maximum rating evaluation, the claim will be set to *RFD*.

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Deferrals on Automated Decision Support Claims









Creating a Deferral on Automated Decision Support Claim

- When doing a partial rating with a deferral on a contention associated with an ADS claim, users need to create a deferral in VBMS-R *and* VBMS Core.
 - VBMS-R: Provides explanation to Veteran and Quality on why the contention is being deferred
 - VBMS-Core: Necessary for capturing data on ADS claims









- When deferring a contention associated with an ADS claim in VBMS-R, enter one of the following deferral reasons on the Analysis Screen
 - Contention requires an examination because evidence surfaced is not sufficient for rating purposes
 - Contention requires additional development

- Once the partial rating is completed in VBMS Rating, navigate to VBMS Core to initiate the deferral. If the claim is deferred for an examination, select *Exam* as the Primary Reason and *Examination Needed* as the Detailed Reason.
- Using this deferral reason is important for data purposes because it is the only reason that links a contention to the deferral.

 Quality assurance for Automated Decision Support is currently following a tiered Interim Quality Assurance plan (IQAP)





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QMS Special Focus Review (SFR)

- The QMS SFR looks specifically at Automated Decision Support outputs for completeness
 If the ARSD is complete and contains the correct information
 - ✓ Whether a VA examination was scheduled appropriately
- SFRs are errors called on Automated Decision Support and not tied to any individual user









Independent Quality Review (IQR)

 The IQAP IQR is considered the "apples to apples approach"



 Focuses on pulling random complete rating decisions for review to determine if Automated Decision Support is causing quality in rating decisions to increase or decrease











Helpful Tips and Tricks and Resources









Helpful Tips and Tricks

- The ARSD can be used as part of evidence review, but users will still need to review all pertinent pieces of evidence and note it within the Rating Decision.
- When establishing local routing rules, have a clear understanding of Prior Assignment and Avoidable Deferral Routing
- It is helpful to base local routing rules off Automated Decision Support Special Issues:
 - Rapid RFD
 - Automated APC
