What is the Medical EPSS

Clarify that the focus of this lesson is not just to show trainees how to use the Medical EPSS tool but to allow them to use the tool to gain a better understanding of the body system and to gain proficiency in using this research tool to maximize claims processing time.

Access Medical EPSS from the Rating Job Aids site and demostrate the tools available, specifically highlighting the "search" and "tool" features

of this site. Give a brief demonstration of how to use these tools to research information found in medical records. Depending on the knowledge level of the trainees, you may want to ask one of the to demonstrate the tool. Emphasize how to access the tutorials and how the highlighted and underlined words are links to other information. Ask a trainee to provide a term, condition, or abbreviation to search for. Search for medical terminology you have selected using these various sources.

Demonstrate the other medical references available on the Rating Job Aids page. Emphasize how simply searching on the medical term or abbreviation using common internet search engines may be sufficient to find the necessary information.

- Medical Abbreviations
- MedicineNet.com

The C&P Medical EPSS provides tutorial information related to medical terminology and issues, and numerous graphics to illustrate various medical definitions and concepts. Medical EPSS provides a general tutorial on each body system in the Rating Schedule. There is information regarding the function of the body system and common conditions. The system has excellent visual aids to supplement the material. The system has endless links to obtain more information on specific diseases, body parts, and medical terms.

WARNING: Medical EPSS should not be used as a diagnostic tool for yourself or your loved ones. Please leave that to the medical professionals.
