



## ELITE INSTRUCTOR PROGRAM: NEW CANDIDATE TMS JOB AID

### Purpose

The purpose of this job aid is to guide New ELITE Candidates through the process of accessing the ELITE training in TMS 2.0.

1. **Log in** to TMS 2.0 through Single Sign-On (recommended) or through Password/Passcode.




Figure 2: VA TMS 2.0 Password/Passcode Page

3. From the drop-down menu **Select** > Learning.




Figure 4: TMS 2.0 Home Screen Drop-down Menu

4. In the To-Do Keyword search **Enter** > ELITE.




Figure 5: To-Do Keyword Search

6. Find ELITE Prerequisite Instructor Training Course (ITC) and **Select** > START COURSE.




Figure 7: ELITE Prerequisite Instructor Training Course (ITC)




Figure 9: Exam results—required level of proficiency demonstrated




Figure 10: Exam results—required level of proficiency not demonstrated
