Lesson Overview

Purpose of the Lesson:	This lesson will provide LIEs and FEs the ability to respond to STAR errors cited using BFFS.	
Prerequisite Training Requirements:	Prior to taking the STAR Review in BFFS – End User lesson, LIEs and FEs must have completed work items subject to review in BFFS.	
Target Audience:	This lesson is for LIEs and FEs subject to quality review that are currently using BFFS to conduct daily workload.
