Non-Federal - VBA does not process receiving reports (RR) - MO

Certified Invoice - used for non-Federal certified invoice that does not require a receiving report. (XXXJX2000 - XXXJX3999)

C. Employee Reimbursement

Federal Invoice - Generally are not processed through IPAC. May include both services and Supplies. In this case, a servicing agency will process an IM transaction to collect from the buyer's obligation. (XXXJX5000 - XXXJX7999)

A. VHA to VBA or vice versa

B. VBA to VBA

C. VBA to NCA

Federal Billing - Generally processed through IPAC. (XXXJX8000 - XXXJX9999)

A. GSA - Motorpool and RWA

B. DHS - SWA C. FOH - EAP D. GPO

Below are examples using the numbering schema.

GSA (Inter-Agency) XXXJ0<u>8</u>00X FOH (Inter-Agency) XXXJ0<u>8</u>00X VHA (Intra - Agency) XXXJ0<u>5</u>000

Inter-Agency (Outside the VA) numbering schema - sixth digit always begins with the number 8 and the Intra-Agency (Within the VA) begins with the number 5.

Finally, the numbering schema established for 2237 is XXXJX4000 - JX4999.

The standard numbering schema consist of a nine-digit alphanumerica code that may not be duplicated.

5. The **seventh** through ninth position sequential.

1. The <u>first</u> three postions represent the station number (numbers only)
2. The <u>fourth</u> position consists of an alpha code that idenifies the appropriation
3. The <u>fifth</u> position consists of the fiscal year of the appropriation
4. The <u>sixth</u> position further idenfies the type of obligation. In this case, Interagency Agreement with federal agency. An IPAC will be processed by the seller.
