Discussion:

A trend analysis was conducted regarding errors cited on National STAR Pension Quality Reviews completed between the months of **March 2024 and April 2024** (transactions completed between February 1, 2024, through March 31, 2024). STAR reviews are performed the following month after a claim is completed.


Out of a total of **94** claims reviewed for quality, **23** claims had a total of **32** errors cited; **2** of those claims had BE errors.

4 reconsiderations (recons) were submitted. 1 non-BE error was overturned, 3 are still pending.

The **32** cited errors were within the following categories:

The *Error Drill Down* graph below details the errors broken out by category/reasons:



Inaccurate notification letters continue to be the highest area of errors. Please continue to include all appropriate attachments and be sure to proofread for accuracy before releasing. Income counting and medical expense counting errors accounted for many errors and all the BE errors for these two months. Please be sure to communicate to the VSRs they are reviewing their claims for issues that would cause BE errors, such as income and medical calculations, income counting rules, effective dates, service eligibility and all claimed issues (like reviewing for A&A).

Procedural inaccuracies continue to increase. Please remind VSRs to review for ALL issues, perform complete development actions applicable simultaneously, and check the EP, claim labels and date of claims for accuracy.

Note that over the last 12 months, nine BE errors have been cited for Ratings and 11 for Authorization claims. While accuracy has improved for March and April 2024, increased BE errors in following months may cause accuracy to decrease below national goals.

- September 8, 2023 SOP v4 released. Latest updates. (Reminder)
- May 1, 2024 P&F released consolidated and updated FAQ document. It is posted on the P&F PACT Intranet site.
- May 3, 2024 P&F Inquiry Response Highlights published clarification regarding burial reconsiderations.

PACT Burial Reconsiderations

For DIC reevaluations under the PACT Act where DIC was denied *prior to December 16, 2016* (PL114-315), *and* there was an accompanying burial claim previously decided from the same claimant, award SC burial benefits upon granting DIC on a PACT reevaluation. The claimant does not need to submit a new burial claim.

PL 114-315 is specific to allowing the payment of burial benefits without a claim when the Veteran's death occurred on or after December 16, 2016, however, this provision is distinct on granting benefits without the submission of a claim. M21-1, Part XI, Subpart iii, 1.B.2.h allows for the payment of additional SC burial benefits when the non-service-connected burial allowance has been paid. This guidance should also be applied to scenarios described above to grant SC burial benefits when a previously decided burial claim for the claimant is of record. Additionally, 38 CFR 3.1703(b)(1) allows for payment of burial benefits when VA receives a

claim, except as provided in <u>38 CFR 3.1702(a)</u>. There is no distinction that a "new" claim or application must be filed for burial benefits to be paid later.

- Please use the correct SI when identifying a PACT claim: PACT or PACT ACT DIC
 Reevaluation SIs must be applied correctly on DIC contentions to indicate the correct type of
 PACT claim in VBMS Core.
- The TERA Conceded and TERA Not Conceded is an integral part of tracking PACT decisions.
 A reminder to all raters to please apply the correct rating special issue (TERA Conceded or TERA Not Conceded) on claims that meet the TERA threshold appropriately.
