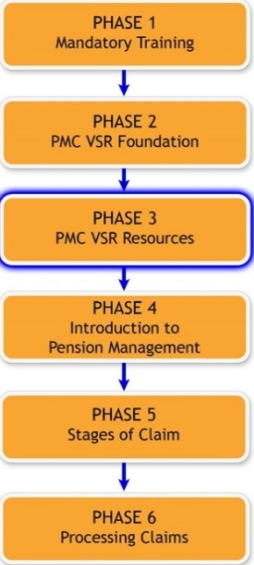

<p>Why It Matters!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All claims require systems to process • You will use systems to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Initiate claims ○ Develop evidence for claims ○ Promulgate the awards for claims ○ Notify the claimant of actions taken on the claim • If you don't know which system to use or how to access it, you can't do the work of the PMC VSR. • Not knowing the systems has a rippling effect in terms of errors. Ultimately, it is the Veteran who will be affected.
