Worksheet: Where to CEST?

For each scenario, determine whether the claim should be established in VBMS or in SHARE, and why.

- A surviving spouse submits a claim for survivor's pension benefits on February 26, 2016. The Veteran was receiving compensation rated at 20% prior to his death. Should this claim be established in VBMS or SHARE? Why?
- A Veteran files a claim for non-service connected pension benefits on March 3, 2016. He has never filed a claim for benefits prior to his claim for non-service connected pension. Should this claim be established in VBMS or SHARE? Why?
- A surviving spouse files a claim for DIC and survivors pension benefits on March 6, 2016. The Veteran had never filed a claim for compensation or pension benefits. Should the claim be established in VBMS or SHARE? Why?
- 4. A Veteran files a dual claim for compensation and non-service connected pension benefits on January 1, 2016. He has never filed a claim prior to this. Should the claim be established in VBMS or SHARE? Why?
- A Veteran files a claim for non-service connected pension benefits on April 9, 2016. He currently has a compensation award of 10% disabling. Should the claim be established in VBMS or SHARE? Why?

Practice Exercise: Unestablished EP

Instructions: Read the following scenario and use the VA Form 21P-530, Application for Burial Benefits, provided by the instructor, to CEST the record in SHARE.

Scenario: While working on an established survivors pension claim with a BIRLS record and a validated record in COVERS, you reviewed the VA Form 21-534EZ (Application for DIC, Death Pension and/or Accrued Benefits), received May 5, 2015, and supporting evidence in VVA. You found that a VA Form 21P-530 (Application for Burial Benefits, for nonservice-connected burial) was also received May 5, 2015, but no burial claim is pending.

A review of the Corporate Record showed no burial claim (160 series) with a date of claim of May 5, 2015. No burial award tab existed. You must CEST the claim.
