They should have completed the following three lessons from Phase 3: VA Terminology Pension Website References EXPLAIN that this lesson will introduce trainees to the EPSSs they will use as PMC VSRs. Trainees will locate and use the EPSSs they need on the job.

 Why It Matters! An Electronic Performance Support System (EPSS) provides step-by-step guidance for performing complex and/or infrequently performed tasks. Use of EPSSs reduces errors. 	 DISPLAY slide 3. "Why It Matters!" ASK trainees if they have ever used an electronic help tool in software. ASK trainees if they have ever used tax-preparation software? ASK trainees if they have used navigation tools like GPSs or map applications on their phones to find the way to a new destination.
	EXPLAIN that these are examples of different forms of Electronic Performance Support Systems or EPSSs. EPSSs help you to perform new, difficult, and infrequent tasks.
	NOTE the difference between a job aid and an EPSS is that a job aid usually provides useful information about a portion of a task, whereas an EPSS provides step by step guidance on an entire task.

"EPSSs for the PMC VSR" EXPLAIN that EPSSs relevant to a novice PMC VSR include: Income/Net Worth Effective Dates Due Process Incompetency Character of Discharge (COD) Determination Hospital Adjustments PMC VSR Job Aids, located in the VSR Assistant from the PMC VSR button NOTE the other EPSSs displayed are for VSRs in Compensation service. DEMONSTRATE where to locate the VSR Assistant EPSS portal from the VBA Intranet. DIRECT the trainees to do the same on their computers. Assist trainees who have difficulty.

"Selecting EPSS" EXPLAIN that each EPSS supports performance of a different action or actions in claim processing. VSRs may use one or more EPSS to complete a claim, depending on the type of claim and the characteristics of the claim.

- 1. Which of the six EPSSs for the PMC VSR include a tutorial?
 - o Incompetency EPSS (first page of this EPSS)
 - o Income and Net Worth Determination EPSS (first page of this EPSS; it is called an overview, but it is a tutorial)
 - o Character of Discharge EPSS (first page of this EPSS)

- Effective Dates EPSS (first page of this EPSS)
- Due Process EPSS (first page of this EPSS; it is called an overview, but it is a tutorial)
- 2. What is the VA definition of incompetency?
 - o The VA defines a mentally incompetent person as one who, because of injury or disease, lacks the mental capacity to contract or to manage his or her affairs, including disbursement of funds without limitation. (glossary; page 2 of the tutorial in the Incompetency EPSS)
- 3. What is the CFR reference for effective dates?
 - o 38 CFR 3.400 (page 1 of effective dates EPSS tutorial)
- 4. Define IVAP.
 - Income for VA Purposes (glossary; Income and Net Worth Determination EPSS tutorial first page.)
- 5. What is the wartime period for the Vietnam era?
 - o Aug. 5, 1964 to May 7, 1975 (Feb. 28, 1961, for Veterans who served "in country" before Aug. 5, 1964) (resources; wartime periods)
- 6. What are the CFR references applied for adjusting a Veteran's benefits as he or she is readmitted into a facility?
 - 38 CFR 3.551 and 38 CFR 3.552 (Hospital Adjustments EPSS > Readmission link > first page)
