Purpose of the Lesson:	This lesson is part of the entry-level curriculum Core Course for PMC VSRs. The purpose of this lesson is to prepare PMC VSRs to verify proof of the cause of death of the Veteran for survivors' pension claims.

EMPHASIZE to trainees that each of these lessons relates to the others as part of the tasks beyond basic eligibility and determining if a claim is ready to rate.

INFORM trainees that this lesson will focus on how to verify the proof of death of a Veteran in order for a surviving spouse, child, or parent to receive survivors' benefits or DIC benefits.

Why Is Verifying Proof of Death Important?  • Verifying proof of death of a Veteran is important because a surviving child, spouse, or parent of a Veteran can receive benefits only if proof of death is received showing the Veteran's cause of death.  • Benefits include:  • Survivors' pension  • DIC	DISPLAY slide 10. REFER trainees to the CFR regarding evidence needed for proof of death:  38 CFR 3.211 (Death)  38 CFR 3.202 (Evidence from Foreign Countries)  Give trainees a few minutes to read through the sections, and then choose a trainee to summarize each section.  REVIEW the points given on the slide and provide any additional knowledge or experiences you may have regarding the evidence needed for proof of death.  ENSURE understanding of the importance of receiving and verifying proof of death to receive survivors' pension and/or DIC benefits.

"Verifying Proof of Death"  NAVIGATE to the BIRLS VID screen via SHARE  DEMONSTRATE in SHARE comparing the date of death and the SHARE print screen.  EXPLAIN that if the Veteran's death was a homicide, then there is a need to develop for a police report to ensure that spouse did not commit the murder. If the spouse committed the murder, benefits would be denied unless it was self-defense.  ASK the trainees if they have any questions about verifying proof of death in SHARE or on the BIRLS VID screen.
